

RBSC Trail Coordinator Report Oct 19/14

During the past few weeks we have been able to get out and do some work on our trails and shelters and with weather permitting we will continue to do more. Unfortunately, despite posting work days on the web site, the volunteer response has not been good. It has been the same few people doing the work each and every time. Many thanks to those individuals who continually volunteer their time! To date we have cleared the Kids lake Trail from the Elaine Lake Road to the Musquash shelter and from the shelter East to the Beaver dam. We have also cleared the Ashley Trail West of Highway 2 to the second washout. This week we will attempt to clear the Kids Lake trail going west from the Rock Lake Road. Also other trail clearing days will be scheduled in the coming weeks.

There have been several washouts on our trails which we have attempted to repair. On the designated Ashley trail there were two major washouts. We were able to find a culvert and repair one, but the other has yet to be fixed. There is also water over the trails in several places on the Kid's Lake trail.

In Sept. our regular work crew spent a full day at the Musquash shelter, cleaning up the yard, cutting firewood and fixing up the shelter itself. It is now ready for the snowmobile season which will soon be here.

There are no further developments in regards to our designated trail proposal to the Musquash shelter as it is still under review by the government authorities.

I am proposing that we purchase a new groomer for our trails which I will address later in the meeting.
