The Centre Shelter

- The trail section from the River Trail to the new Centre Shelter area has been cleared; the trail section to the lake remains to be cleared. Watch for stumps on this trail.
- Would like to make the trail wider if possible, hopefully people can assist with this when they go out clearing/riding.

Musquash Shelter

- The Kid's Lake Trail was cleared to Musquash; there are beaver dams along the trail that need to freeze more to make it safer
- Propane level good; BBQ was knocked off the deck but replaced and functional
- The lights aren't working
- Would like to try to clear through the lakes to Musquash in 2 weeks but will need some volunteers

George Lake Shelter

- The trail is cleared to George Lake Shelter, the ice is not the safest yet, needs to freeze more
- Propane level good
- Looks like people were in the shelter in the fall

Thunder Mountain Shelter

- No one has been through that trail yet

Other Trails

- The trail to Cheeyas was accessed and cleaned via the sand pit trail
